Dr. Hite,

Here is my original email to Mr. Zahn. Yes, I was disturbed to find that the programming schedule that has years been available 24 hours on line for the school system's television station was suddenly unavailable. You were copied on my response to Mr. Coleman after it was apparent he was more concerned with how this missing information made him look rather than resolving the problem. Moreover, he never demonstrated leadership by providing the information I was seeking. Instead he provided me every excuse under the sun as to why the information was unavailable. Sure I was upset, but as the leader of the Communication Department, Mr. Coleman should understand his role and taken steps to defuse this situation. Instead he stoops to childish words like bullying. Demanding the services I am afforded as a stakeholder and taxpayer is not bullying; it's called accountability.

Seeing that Mr. Coleman does not know the difference explains why after trying to take a break from dealing with school system issues, I continue to receive calls from parents and community leaders about how the school system is not transparent and putting up barriers that prevent parents and other stakeholders access to basic information.
